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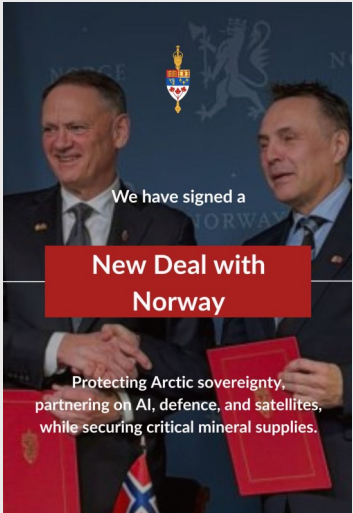

This pragmatic business-like approach is how we are driving economic and national resilience while creating new jobs for Canadians, right here at home.

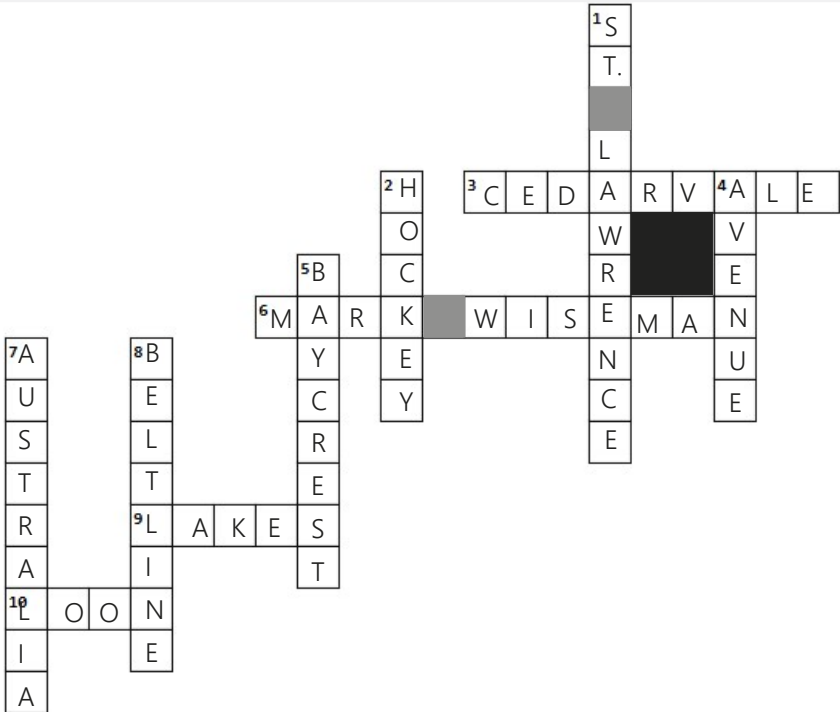

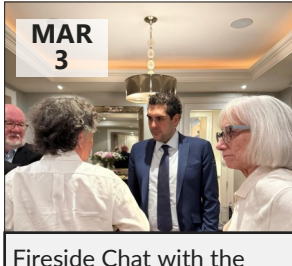

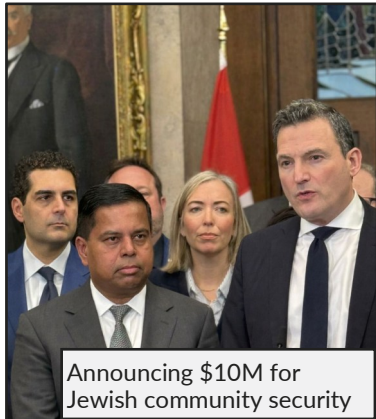

THE FIGHT AGAINST CRIME:

Our frontline police officers and national security apparatus need to be able to react to serious threats quickly—that means updating lawful access laws.

With lawful access, law enforcement are able to swiftly obtain critical information during an emergency investigation.

Currently, Canada is the only G7 country without modernized lawful access standards. It is vital that we give law enforcement modern tools that reflect the reality on the ground so they can swiftly respond to serious threats such as terrorism, kidnapping, and extortion.

Updating lawful access will allow our officers to move faster, keeping our communities safe.
